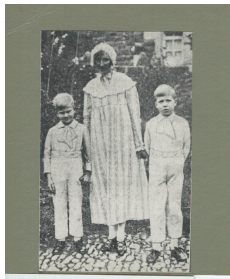

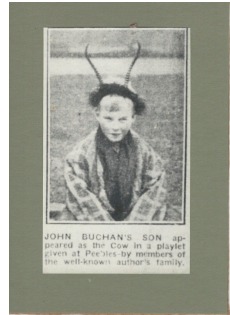


Bank House

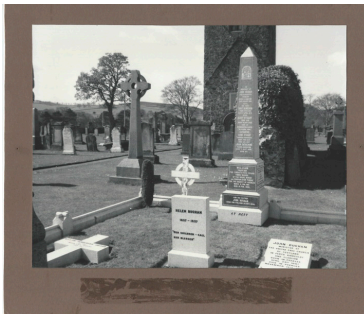
